UPDATE

To the individuals we support, their families, and our community partners,

On February 26, 2021, the Ontario Government announced that nine public health regions would move to new levels in the [COVID-19 Response Framework: Keeping Ontario Safe and Open](#).

These changes took effect on Monday, March 1, 2021 at 12:01 am and included:

- Niagara Region moved to the Red Zone - Control.
- Haldimand-Norfolk moved to the Yellow Zone – Protect.

In response to this announcement and with guidance from the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services and Public Health, the following modification will be implemented:

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

Our administrative staff will return to work out of our Schmon and Fly Road locations on a partial rotating basis, effective Monday, March 8, 2021.

At this time, Children's Services, Adult Residential Services, and Adult Clinical Services will continue to operate as previously communicated, maintaining the enhanced measures implemented.
